New for all Users

1. A new site catalog combines the ability to browse, filter or search for courses, Programs, and/or Certifications. The grid or list layouts display tiles that can be customized to present a variety of information.
2. The Navigation block no longer appears by default on site pages, as the main or top-navigation menu is meant as the site level navigation tool. On a course page, the new Course Navigation block only displays links relevant to the course.
3. Learning plan approval workflow has been streamlined so that managers can approve/deny learning plan requests directly from the task opened from the Tasks block.
4. To protect user privacy, site managers no longer have default access to report columns relating to a user's performance, although this permission can be granted by a site administrator.

New for Course Developers

1. Can rename resources and activities from the main course page.
2. Can multi-select questions to delete in **Quiz**.
3. In **Quiz** activities, question type icons are displayed in the manual grading overview.
4. A custom image can be assigned to each course. This image can be presented as an identifying feature for the learning item when displayed within the site catalog or within a Featured links block.
5. New workflow for adding blocks provides a separate add function to each block region available on the page.
6. New block configuration option allows for the block's display name to be customized, of the block header to be removed.
7. New full-width header and footer block regions are available on course pages.
8. Can now restrict access to an activity based on the time since completion of another activity.
9. The ability to sign up for multiple seminar events can now be controlled by the learner's previous attendance status.
10. Course completion reports can now include a column for the note recorded against a Recognition of Prior Learning.

New for Site Administrators

1. The main menu bar now offers two levels of sub-menus.
2. A default image for course, Programs, and/or Certifications can be established at the site level. This image will be used for learning items that do not have their own image assigned.
3. A custom image can be assigned to each Program and Certification. This image can be presented as an identifying feature for the learning item when displayed within the site catalog or within a Featured links block.
4. A central new block region is available on the front page.
5. The gallery tile-type for Featured Links blocks now offers a variety of configuration settings, and the ability to set a separate URL for each tile within the gallery.
6. Seminar notifications now support the Multi-language filter.
7. Course type can now be defined via course uploads.
8. The HR Import **General settings** page has been replaced with **Default settings**. This defines the default settings for all HR Import elements, although each element can now override the defaults individually.
9. New Competencies source/element has been added to HR Import allowing for the import of Competency hierarchies.
10. Several report columns have been noted as “deprecated”. While still available and functional in this version of Totara Learn, it is advised that clients proactively consider altering reports that use these columns, as they will be removed in future versions of the LMS.
11. A new dynamic Audience rule is available to control Audience membership based on the user’s authentication method.
12. A new dynamic Audience rule is available to control Audience membership based on Certification status or completion date.
13. Can now restrict content displayed in reports by Audience membership.
